

## WHO IS USING SITEREC?

At one of the channel tunnel rail sites in London, we have 16 clocking windows working with proximity cards on a large scale. The workforce is approximately 1,800. This is a combination of directly employed and sub-contract labour. The proximity card, once activated via FaceRec can be used across the whole site for access into the office areas, compounds and restricted areas. At the end of the day, FaceRec inactivates the card.
